



Biblical Standard of Behavior

The ultimate purpose at Concord Christian Academy is to partner with parents in training their children both spiritually and academically. CCA endeavors to train each child educationally, physically, spiritually, and socially in a Biblical context. We aim in helping students develop a Christ like behavior and attitude at school, at home, and in our community. It is therefore imperative that parents and students who enjoy the privilege of enrollment of CCA agree to the Biblical Standard of Behavior that the school has established.

CCA desires students who make conscious choices based on the principles of the Word of God rather than accepting worldly values and behaviors. The truth presented in Charles Sheldon’s classic *In His Steps* where each person in the community asks themselves “What Would Jesus Do” forms the basis of our Biblical Standard of Behavior. To this end, all CCA students agree that they will strive to:

Honor Authority (*Ephesians 6:1-2; Romans 13:1-2; Hebrews 13:17*)

- Obey parental, school, church, and civil authorities
- Cooperate with those in authority
- Respect for those in positions of authority

Display Christ like Attitudes (*Psalm 1:1; Philippians 2:5; Ephesians 4:29*)

- Refrain from gossip, slander, and verbally hurting others
- Resolve personal conflicts in a manner that pleases God and promotes peace
- Refrain from mocking and scornful communication
- Recommend and practice forgiveness

Obey the Biblical Standard of Morality (*1 Corinthians 6:18-20, Exodus 20:7, 1 Timothy 2:9*)

- Abstain from the possession and use of alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs
- Avoid using profanity or vulgarity
- Abstain from sexual sins
- Avoid dressing immodestly, not causing others to stumble
