Concord Christian Academy has a uniform policy for all students. It is our belief that uniforms improve the Christian learning environment in several important aspects:

1. Reduce non-academic distractions.
2. Less stress on parents.
3. Improved relations between students and teachers.
4. Improved feeling of community.

(Please note that all sweaters & polo shirts must be embroidered. All hoodies & sweatshirts must have the CCA logo. All boys' pants and girls' jumpers, skirts and pants must be purchased via CCA dress code guidelines listed on the website above. Accessories including belts, shoes, socks, etc may be purchased anywhere but must follow the guidelines noted below.)

- **PRE-SCHOOL AND ELEMENTARY UNIFORM POLICY (K3 through 5th grade):**
 - **Girls' Jumpers:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above; they must come to the bottom of the knee when standing or sitting
 - **Girls' Shirts:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above; may be short or long sleeved. Girls' polo shirts must be embroidered with the CCA logo.
 - **Girls' Pants:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Pants must have embroidered cross on the leg.
 - **Boys' Pants:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Pants must have embroidered cross on the leg.
 - **Boys' Shirts:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Shirts may be short or long sleeved and must be embroidered with the CCA logo.
 - **Belts (boys):** Belts are required if the shirt is tucked into the pants.
 - **Sweaters (all):** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above, must be embroidered with the CCA logo.
 - **Footwear** – Non-marking shoes or sneakers may be worn.
 - **Socks/Tights:** black, navy blue or white. Navy blue or white leggings for girls are also permitted during winter months. (December thru March). No other hosiery is acceptable.
 - **CCA Hoodies are permitted to be worn during the school day with the school uniform underneath.**
 - **Gym Attire (3rd through 5th grades):** Tee shirts or Concord Christian Academy tee shirts, knee length shorts, sneakers.

- **MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY (6th – 12th Grades):**

- **Girls' Skirts:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above; they must come to the bottom of the knee when standing or sitting. Parents are responsible for their child wearing the proper size and length skirt; short and/or tight skirts are not permitted.
- **Girls' Shirts:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Blouses may be short or long sleeved, polo shirts must be embroidered with the CCA logo.
- **Girls' Pants:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Pants must have embroidered cross on the leg.
- **Boys' Pants:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Pants must have embroidered cross on the leg.
- **Boys' Shirts:** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above. Shirts may be short or long sleeved and must be embroidered with the CCA logo.
- **Belts (boys):** Belts are required if the shirt is tucked into the pants.
- **Sweaters (all):** Ordered directly from one of the suppliers listed above, must be embroidered with the CCA logo.
- **Footwear: Footwear –** Non-marking shoes or sneakers may be worn.
- **Socks/Tights:** Black, navy blue or white. Navy blue or white leggings for girls are also permitted during winter months. (December thru March). No other hosiery is acceptable.
- **CCA Hoodies are permitted to be worn during the school day with the school uniform underneath.**
- **Gym Attire (middle and high school):** Tee shirts or Concord Christian Academy tee shirts, knee length shorts, sneakers.

- **Spirit Day/Dollar Denim Day Uniform (see purchasing links on front page):**

Many times during the school year CCA will have spirit day. Every Friday is dollar denim day, meaning students can choose to bring \$1 to school and dress in spirit day attire. Proceeds benefit the senior class. Spirit day attire consists of the following:

Girls: Girls may wear denim jean skirts to below the knee when standing and sitting. Girls may not wear jeans.

Boys: Denim jeans (no rips, tears, or holes).

All: CCA t-shirts, sweatshirts, hoodies, and uniform shirts. Sneakers are allowed. Sweatpants, track pants, and leggings are not acceptable spirit day attire.

- **General Uniform Policy Information:**

The uniform policy was written with you, the parent, in mind. It is as simple as it can possibly be and hopefully will make your back-to-school shopping less stressful. All students are expected to be in uniform the first day of school and each and every day of the school year. The only exceptions will be on designated spirit or casual days. Any student in uniform violation is subject to points. If a student is out of dress code, a parent or guardian may be contacted and the student will be required to have a proper uniform brought to them or taken home for the day. Only those uniforms mentioned are permitted to be worn.
